The ICAR-NRCP team has observed the ‘Swachhta of nearby tourist spot’ on 01.10.2017 as part of the Swachhta Hi Seva campaign. The tourist spot selected was Siddheshwar temple, famously known as ‘Temple at the pond’ located at the heart of the Solapur city. The activity was coordinated by Dr. N.Gaikwad and Shri. AS Babar.

Activities undertaken at the tourist spot – Siddeheshwar temple:

- **Cleaning at the footpath:** The litters thrown at the footpath of entrance side of temple were collected.
- **Cleaning beneath the shade trees:** The leaves dropped beneath the shade trees were collected.
- **Cleaning at the bank of eco-pond:** The leaves and litters at the bank of eco-pond of Siddheshwar temple were collected.
- **Disposing of litters:** The leaves, waste material, papers and other litters collected at footpath, near shade trees, bank of eco-pond were transferred to plastic crates and disposed into the dust bin.
- The footpath at the entrance side of Siddeshwar temple was left neat and clean for the benefit of tourists visiting the temple on 01.10.2017.
